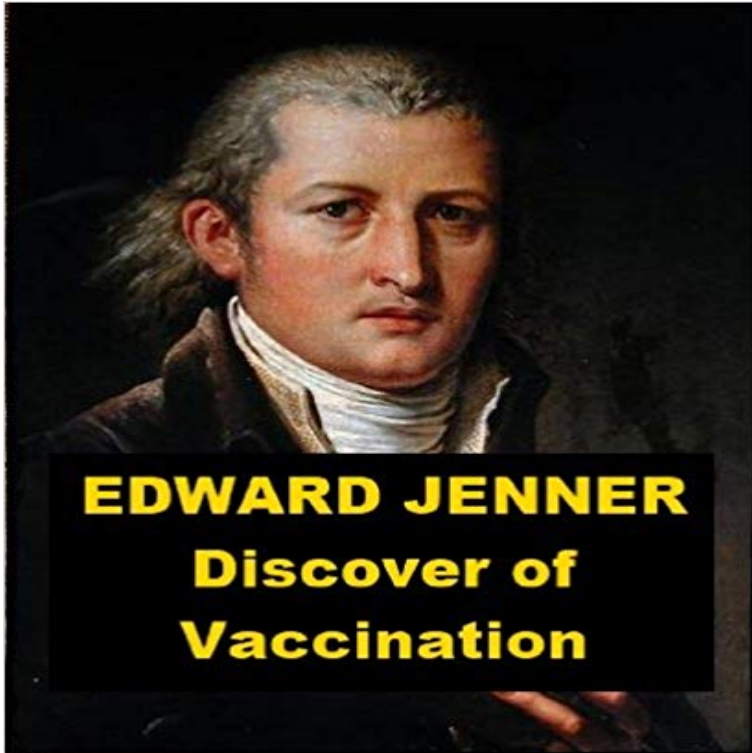

Several days later, Jenner exposed the boy to smallpox. He was found to be immune.
